








Top issues: global results











Detailed results for ITALY (10 answers)

How do you expect your turnover to change when compared to the same period the previous year?






Operating profits compared to the previous year



Have you expanded security measures around your exhibitions / your venues in recent months?






The Trade Show Triangle ...the balance is shifting












Evolution of the show floor

- Coordination and allocation of exhibition centers and expositions nationwide
- Reduction of obstacles that affect fair market competition
- Rationalization of the relationship between government and market
- Reduction of government exhibitions
- > Establish standards of venue safety, management and services
- > Support domestic organizers to "go global" and hold exhibitions overseas
- Protection of intellectual property rights
- Subsidies to SMEs for domestic and overseas exhibitions
- Optimize custom clearance for exhibition products
- Provide training and education for (future) employees in the exhibition industry
